- <u>Urgent but Not Important:</u> Delegate if possible (e.g., club meeting logistics).
- Neither Urgent nor Important: Eliminate or limit (e.g., excessive social media use).

Professional School **Application Deadlines**

Application deadlines for pre-health professional programs vary depending on the specific profession and application service. It is extremely important to meet with your pre-health directors to discuss your application in depth. Do NOT wait until the deadline to apply to your program. Below is a general guide for common pre-health programs:

• AMCAS (MD Programs)

o Opens: Early May

Submission Begins: Late May/Early June

AACOMAS (DO Programs)

o Opens: Early May

Submission Begins: Early June

AADSAS (Dental)

Opens: Early May

Submission Begins: Early June

CASPA (Physician Assistant)

o Opens: Late April

• PharmCAS (Pharmacy)

Opens: Mid-July

OptomCAS (Optometry)

Opens: Late June

• PTCAS (Physical Therapy)

Opens: Early July

• OTCAS (Occupational Therapy)

Opens: Mid-July

VMCAS (Veterinary)

Opens: Mid-January
